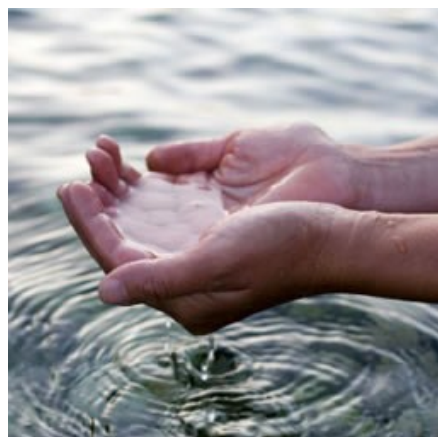
Wellsprings of Generosity: Giving as a Spiritual Practice

Where does generosity come from, and how can we cultivate a “culture of generosity” that grows naturally out of the life of faith? This seminar gets at the heart of what it means to follow a generous God by looking at: 1. Practicing hospitality as key to cultivating generosity and mission; 2. New insights into scripture: reading the Rich Young Man and Zacchaeus with new eyes; 3. The Lord’s Supper as the pattern for the Christian practice of receiving and giving; and 4. Rethinking stewardship and our identity as Christians.



Carol F. Johnston has written and taught seminars on faith and giving all across North America and as far afield as China on issues of economics and environment, justice, Bible and nature, faith and giving, and the public roles of churches. She serves on the Advisory Board of the Lake Family Institute on Faith and Giving of the Indiana University Center on Philanthropy.
